Live Broadcast or Videotaping

Individuals may broadcast or videotape public school district events, including open board meetings, as long as it does not interfere with or disrupt the school district event and it does not create an undue burden in adapting the buildings and sites to accommodate the request.

It is within the discretion of the superintendent or designee to determine whether the request is unduly burdensome and whether the broadcast or videotaping will interfere with or disrupt the school district event.

Videotaping of classroom activities will be allowed at the discretion of the superintendent, designee or of the building principal.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent or designee to develop administrative regulations outlining the procedures for making the request and the rules for operation if the request is granted.
